- 'Godfearers' present for the passover festival
- 'Look how the whole world has gone after him!' v 19
- Their approach focuses Jesus' mind on his mission

Four images of Jesus' mission

- Being glorified
- A seed falling into the ground
- Judgement on the world, and throwing out the world's price
- Being lifted up

Jesus will be glorified v 23

- God's glory: the shining light of God's presence
 - Jesus' glory seen in his death on the cross

Jesus will be glorified v 23

- God's glory: the shining light of God's presence
- Jesus' 'hour'
- Jesus is 'troubled' v 27
 - focuses on his mission
 - prays for God's glory v 28
 - God speaks v 28
