 - Aeneas 9:34
- we can approach Jesus with confidence 9:14, 21

Guarantee of Jesus' return

- he will return in the same way
 v 11
- 'Heaven must receive [Jesus] until the time comes for God to restore everything' 3:21
- we can look forward to Jesus' return with confidence

Enables the Spirit's coming

twofold promise of the Spirit
 vv 5, 8

'I baptize you with water. But one who is more powerful than I will come, the thongs of whose sandals I am not worthy to untie. He will baptise you with the Holy Spirit and fire.'


Luke 3:16
