### Trade guilds in Thyatira


- Religious basis: patron god(s)
  - Apollo Tyrimneaus
- Banquets involving
  - Food offered to the patron god
  - Access to prostitutes
- Basis of social recognition and progress

- feet like burnished bronze coppersmiths in Thyatira

  - Elijah confronted Baal's prophets on Mount Carmel 1 Kings 18




- Jezebel
  - Continuing influence through Joram, her son
  - Jehu: 'How can there be peace as long as all the idolatry and witchcraft of your mother Jezebel abound?' 2 Kings 9:22





- Jesus' eyes v 23


