The danger of 'inherited faith': Judges 2:10-19

## Pentecost and its consequences

- the Spirit is poured out Acts 2:1-4
- Jesus is the focus vv 22, 23, 32, 36
- Jesus has been vindicated and attested by God vv 22, 23, 24, 32, 33, 36
- Scripture is fulfilled
  - vv 14-21 = Joel 2:28-32
  - vv 25-28 = Psalm 16:8-11
  - v 31 = Psalm 16:10
  - vv 34-35 Psalm 110:1

- revival = 'an outpouring of the Holy Spirit which restores the people of God to normal spiritual life after a period of corporate decline' (Richard Lovelace)
- 1734-35 in Northampton, New England
  - · flowing from sermons on justification by faith
  - particularly young people: 300+ came to faith in half a year; just 50 over 40 years old
  - six weeks in March and April when four people a day came to faith
  - preceded by many years of prayer

# Jonathan Edwards: criteria for a work of the Spirit of God

- brings conviction of sin
- · exalts Jesus as son of God and saviour of the world
- attacks the kingdom of darkness
- · holds the Scriptures in high esteem
- promotes sound (healthy) doctrine
- · involves an outpouring of love to God and people

## Two biblical examples

- the reign of king Josiah 2 Kings 22:1-24
- the mission of Nehemiah and Ezra to the returned exiles Nehemiah 8
- Ask
  - what role Scripture plays in the renewal of God's people
  - how God's people respond to Scripture
